Ideal candidates for the new Culinary and Restaurant collection include restaurants, cafes, bars, clubs, or any type of presentation kitchen where FDA compliancy and ease of cleaning is important. The crevice-free surfaces of the tiles are specifically designed for areas where contamination from steam, oil, food, and liquids are a constant issue. For small spots and stains, the commercial kitchen ceiling tiles can be removed by hand and wiped with a damp rag using light household cleaners. For more regular, rigorous cleaning or spray-washers, hold-down clips are also available on the Ceilume website.
